In this lesson, you have learned about the uses of personification in a nonfiction story. You will now write an essay that demonstrates what you have learned and how you responded to personification in the story of the cowbirds. You will need a printout of your notes.

- Choose one of the topics below and write an essay.
- Organize your response so that it includes at least <u>three</u> supporting details that you have learned from the reading passage, videos, and other materials in this lesson.
- **Use** at least <u>three</u> vocabulary words (or a form of the words) as part of your supporting details.

Essay Topics

- 1. The warblers are only personified once or twice in the story. If you were to personify them further, what words or phrases would you choose, and why?
- How would you tell the story of the cowbirds without personification? Write a paragraph
 describing the problem they create without using personification, and then explain
 whether it is as likely to get readers interested in the cowbirds as personification
 would.
