- **Use** at least <u>three</u> vocabulary words (or a form of the words) as part of your supporting details.

Essay Topics

- 1. Write in your own words how bullying affects a democratic society.
- 2. "Sticks and stones may break my bones, but words will never hurt me." This is an old saying that many young children are taught. Describe a situation in which this saying is true. Then describe a situation in which this saying is not true. Use examples from the videos and the reading passage in the lesson to support your ideas.
