Essay Topics

- 1. Public health investigations generally follow certain steps to investigate a public health problem. Explain the steps public health officials took to diagnose West Nile virus.
- 2. When public health agencies work together, it can help the investigation of a disease outbreak. Explain how collaborations led to the correct diagnosis during the West Nile virus investigation. Be sure to describe what happened when groups failed to work together early on in the investigation.
